Dear Mr. Burkett:

Thank you for your letter of September 3, 1974, concerning the compulsory attendance laws. Specifically you have asked the age limits created by this act. Children between the ages of seven (7) to sixteen (16) are required to attend school. There are certain exceptions to this age requirement for children who are mentally unable to attend school, or who are married, etc. I am enclosing a copy of the compulsory attendance law. The exceptions to this law are set out at Section 21-757.2.
