Dear Senator Waddell:

The Superintendent of Schools in Allendale County has requested a transfer of a sum of money from the general fund of the county to the fund of the school district. You seek our advice regarding who has the authority to make such a transfer.

Section 16 of the current Appropriations Act for Allendale County [58 STAT. Act No. 1333 at ____ (1974)], provides:
The Allendale County Legislative Delegation is authorized to transfer from the general fund of the county additional funds for necessary county purposes, as the delegation may determine.

Clearly, therefore, the authority to transfer sums from the general fund of the county to the fund of the school district is possessed only by the Allendale County Legislative Delegation. Cf., Letter from John L. Choate to James B. Brandt (attached).
