Dear Mr. Watson:

You have asked this office to render its opinion on the following question:

Is it permissible under the law of South Carolina for the child of a member of a school board of trustees to be employed as a school bus driver?

Section 21-810 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1962) reads as follows:

Members of boards of trustees of any school or school district are hereby forbidden to employ any member of their respective board or any relation within the second degree as a driver of any bus.

It is the opinion of this office that Section 21-810 clearly requires that the answer to the question asked must be no.
