Dear Mr. Busbee:

In answer to your request for advice as to the coverage of Section 22-56, Code of Laws of South Carolina as amended, I am of the opinion that the 1972 amendment to said Section by 1972 Act No. 1015 has the effect of extending the benefit of free tuition to any 'post high school technical education at a state-supported institution.' More specifically, the benefits provided by this 1972 amendment would apply to the technical education centers, which are under the new Board of Technical and Comprehensive Education, plus any other post high school technical and trade schools which are state supported.
