Dear Mr. Ashmore:

In response to your letter of January 31, 1973, it should be noted at the outset that the situation whereby work camps feed table scraps to swine which are, in turn, use for consumption would not come within the unlawful actions provision (Section b) of Bill R1357, H2548 so long as the various units within a work camp do not maintain a common garbage dump where garbage is stored for later consumption by swine.

Nevertheless, though found to come within Section 6, work camps which feed its own garbage to swine that are raised for consumption and not for sale would be exempted from the act pursuant to Section 8 pertaining to exemptions.
